JURASSIC PARK Second Chance Drawing Promotion Rules and Regulations

Drawing Dates

Two (2) second chance drawings will be conducted by the North Carolina Education Lottery ("NCEL" or "Lottery") for the JURASSIC PARK Instant Scratch-Off ticket (Instant Game #006) and JURASSIC PARK Fast Play Game (Game #0039) Second Chance Drawing Promotion ("Promotion") during the promotion entry period, as determined by the NCEL. The tentative drawing schedule for the Promotion is as follows:

Any changes will be announced by the NCEL at the earliest practical date via the NCEL's official website (www.nclottery.com) and the information may also be obtained by calling the Customer Support Center at (866) 934-0289.

Winners

Three (3) Trip Prize Package Winners will be selected in Drawing 1 and four (4) Trip Prize Package Winners will be selected in Drawing 2 during the promotion period. The NCEL reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to substitute any prize with an alternate prize of equal or greater value.

The Hawaii Trip Prize Package

The Hawaii Trip Prize is a six-day, five-night trip for the Hawaii Trip Prizewinner and their one (1) guest to Hawaii (to occur during or around November of 2026). Each winner of a Trip Prize shall be referred to herein as a "**Prizewinner**." Each Trip Prize includes:

• Roundtrip coach airfare for up to two (2) people from any U.S. airport in the 48 U.S. contiguous states, Hawaii, Alaska and Puerto Rico to Daniel K. Inouye International Airport in Honolulu, Hawaii (inclusive of all associated security fees, taxes and surcharges);

Ground transfers between destination Airport and the destination hotels and, if necessary, between hosted activities and event;

- One (1) double occupancy room accommodations (room and room tax only) at a 3-star or better hotel in Oahu, Hawaii for five (5) nights; The age requirement to check into a hotel in Hawaii is eighteen (18) years of age. The Prizewinner, or guest must have a valid credit card or shall be required to post a cash deposit for incidentals in order for the Prizewinner to check into the destination hotel;
- One thousand dollars (\$1,000) less any applicable debt setoff, cash portion of the Trip Prize will be mailed to the Prizewinner by the Lottery's fulfillment partner two (2) weeks prior to the commencement of his or her trip in the Prizewinner's final travel packet via signature required method. If the debt owed exceeds one thousand dollars (\$1,000), the Prizewinner has the option to pay the debt (less the \$1,000) or to forfeit the Trip Prize and allow the Lottery or its partner to designate a proxy to participate in the event for the Prizewinner, and the Prizewinner shall receive any prizes won by the proxy (less applicable tax withholdings and debt setoff);
- Admission for Prizewinner and guest to a welcome reception;
- Prizewinner shall select from a variety of curated tours and activities in and around Oahu for Prizewinner and guest;
- Transportation to the \$1,000,000 JACKPOT CHALLENGE (the "Challenge" or "Event") venue the day of the Event for the Prizewinner and guest;
- Admission to the Event venue for the Prizewinner and guest;
- The Prizewinner, or their duly authorized proxy, shall have one (1) chance to participate in the Challenge for a chance to win up to one million dollars (\$1,000,000) as described in the Event Details below. The Prizewinner's guest may accompany the Prizewinner but will not be eligible to be a participant in the Challenge unless the guest has been appointed as the Prizewinner's duly authorized proxy.

Total estimated retail value of each Trip Prize is \$14,844.26. This value does not include any cash prizes won during the Challenge. Additional conditions apply for any cash prizes won during the Challenge. Except as provided in these Rules, the Trip Prize is non-transferable, non-assignable, and not redeemable for cash.

\$1,000,000 JACKPOT CHALLENGE Event Details

Overview

The CHALLENGE shall be conducted according to event and security procedures (the "Event and Security Procedures") generated by Scientific Games, LLC ("SG" the "Lottery's fulfillment partner") and its third-party underwriters. Final official event details (the "CHALLENGE Details") explaining how the CHALLENGE will be conducted will be provided to the LOTTERY no later than 120 days prior to the date of the CHALLENGE. Capitalized terms used in this Section 11 but not defined in this Agreement shall have the meaning ascribed to them in the Event and Security Procedures or the Official CHALLENGE Details.

The North Carolina Lottery Prizewinners (or their assigned duly authorized proxy) shall participate as a Contestant ("Contestant") in SG's CHALLENGE together with Contestants from other participating lottery jurisdictions. The CHALLENGE consists of one (1) Event. Each Contestant will participate in the CHALLENGE in a series of mini games for the chance to win cash prizes (the "Cash Prizes").

The CHALLENGE will consist of four (4) rounds (each a "**Round**" or plural "**Rounds**"). Each Round will be played separately as follows:

Round 1

This Round features a set of twelve (12) oversized playing cards. For this Round only, there will be two (2) sets of cards for game play, each set with a different card front and back design, to be randomly assigned to each Contestant. Regardless of card set used, the game play remains the same as described further here.

Each Contestant will be presented with a board displaying a set of twelve (12) oversized cards with backs facing out. The Contestant will be asked to choose two (2) cards to reveal a dollar amount. After the Contestant makes their card selection and both cards are revealed, the Contestant will be given one (1) opportunity to replace only one (1) of their two (2) selected cards for another card or to keep the original two (2) cards selected.

-The Contestant will win the total dollar amount of the two (2) cards selected and advance to Round 2.

-If the two (2) cards selected by the Contestant reveal the same dollar amount with exception of the "AUTO WIN" card, the player wins twice (2X) the amount of the two (2) cards selected and advances to Round 2. One (1) "AUTO WIN" card will be included in a set of twelve (12) cards.

-If one (1) of the two (2) cards selected by the Contestant reveals "AUTO WIN", the Contestant will automatically win a total of one thousand dollars (\$1,000) and advance to Round 2.

Round 1 Cash Prizes range from seventy-five dollars (\$75) up to one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

Round 2

This Round will be played using a set of two (2) oversized dice (each a "Die" or plural "Dice"). Each Contestant starts with a bankroll of one-hundred dollars (\$100) (the "**Round 2 Bankroll**") and will roll the two (2) Dice, one (1) at a time. Each Die has six (6) sides of equal size displaying the following messages and multiplier values:

Die #1:

- Three (3) sides display a two-times (2X) multiplier symbol;
- Two (2) sides display a five-times (5X) multiplier symbol; and
- One (1) side displays a "VELOCIRAPTOR" symbol which equates to a one-half ($\frac{1}{2}X$) multiplier.

Die #2:

- Three (3) sides display a two-times (2X) multiplier;
- Two (2) sides display a five-times (5X) multiplier; and
- One (1) side displays a ten-times (10X) multiplier.

After rolling Die #1 and Die #2, the Contestant's one hundred dollars (\$100) Round 2 Bankroll is multiplied by the combined multiplier value for which each Die lands as follows:

- One (1) "2X" and one (1) "VELOCIRAPTOR" = one hundred dollars (\$100);
- One (1) "5X" and one (1) "VELOCIRAPTOR" = two hundred fifty dollars (\$250);
- Two (2) "2X" = four hundred dollars (\$400);
- One (1) "10X" and one (1) "VELOCIRAPTOR" = five hundred dollars (\$500);
- One (1) "2X" and one (1) "5X" = one thousand dollars (\$1,000);
- One (1) "2X" and one (1) "10X" = two thousand dollars (\$2,000);
- Two (2) "5X" = two thousand-five hundred dollars (\$2,500); and
- One (1) "5X" and one (1) "10X" = five thousand dollars (\$5,000).

Round 2 Cash Prizes range from one hundred dollars (\$100) up to five thousand dollars (\$5,000).

The Contestant will win one (1) of the dollar amounts above and advances to Round 3.

Round 3

This Round will be played by spinning a wheel (the "Wheel"). Each Contestant will spin the Wheel two (2) times to win a Cash Prize (each, a "Spin" or plural "Spins"). The Wheel will be divided into twenty-four (24) segments of equal size displaying the following messages and values:

- Two (2) of the segments display the "JURASSIC PARK" logo;
- Two (2) of the segments display the dollar amount "\$5,000";
- Two (2) of the segments display the dollar amount "\$2,500";
- Four (4) of the segments display the dollar amount "\$1,000";
- Twelve (12) of the segments display the dollar amount "\$500"; and

- Two (2) of the segments display the words "RAPTOR ATTACK".
- One (1) of the aforementioned "JURASSIC PARK" segments also displays a gold star symbol and the word "START" which indicates the required starting position of the Wheel prior to each Wheel Spin in Round 3 (the "START Segment").

"Spin #1": Subject to the eligible spin requirements as defined in the official CHALLENGE Details, each Contestant will spin the Wheel, and it will come to rest on a dollar amount segment, the "JURASSIC PARK" segment or the "RAPTOR ATTACK" segment as follows:

- If the Wheel comes to rest on a dollar amount segment, the Contestant wins that dollar amount for Spin #1 and proceeds to Spin #2;
- If the Wheel comes to rest on a "JURASSIC PARK" segment, the Contestant wins \$5,000 in Spin #1 and proceeds to Spin #2;
- If the Wheel comes to rest on a "RAPTOR ATTACK" segment, the Contestant wins nothing in Spin #1 and proceeds to Spin #2; or
- If the Contestant has two (2) ineligible Spins in Spin #1, the Contestant wins \$500 in Spin #1 and proceeds to Spin #2.

"Spin #2": Subject to the eligible Spin requirements as defined in the official CHALLENGE Details, each Contestant will spin the Wheel, and it will come to rest on a dollar amount segment, the "JURASSIC PARK" segment or the "RAPTOR ATTACK" segment as follows:

- If the Wheel comes to rest on a dollar amount segment in Spin #1 and comes to rest on a dollar amount segment again in Spin #2, the Contestant wins the sum of the two dollar amounts and advances to Round 4;
- If the Wheel comes to rest on a dollar amount segment in Spin #1 and comes to rest on a "JURASSIC PARK" segment in Spin #2, the Contestant wins the dollar amount in Spin #1, plus \$5,000 and advances to Round 4;
- If the Wheel comes to rest on a dollar amount segment in Spin #1 and comes to rest on a "RAPTOR ATTACK" segment in Spin #2, the Contestant wins the dollar amount in Spin #1 only and advances to Round 4;
- If the Wheel comes to rest on a dollar amount segment in Spin #1 and has two (2) ineligible spins in Spin #2, the Contestant wins the dollar amount won in Spin #1 plus \$500 in Spin #2 and advances to Round 4;
- If the Wheel comes to rest on a "JURASSIC PARK" segment in Spin #1 and the Wheel comes to rest on a dollar amount segment in Spin #2, the Contestant wins the Spin #2 amount, plus \$5,000 for the "JURASSIC PARK" segment in Spin #1 and advances to Round 4;
- If the Wheel comes to rest on a "JURASSIC PARK" segment in Spin #1 and the Wheel comes to rest on a "RAPTOR ATTACK" segment in Spin #2, the Contestant wins \$5,000 for the "JURASSIC PARK" segment in Spin #1 and advances to Round 4;
- If the Wheel Spin comes to rest on a "JURASSIC PARK" segment in Spin #1 and comes to rest on a JURASSIC PARK segment again in Spin #2, the Contestant wins \$50,000 and advances to Round 4;

- If the Wheel Spin comes to rest on a "JURASSIC PARK" segment in Spin #1 and has two (2) ineligible Spins in Spin #2, the Contestant wins \$5,000 in Spin #1, plus \$500 in Spin 2 and advances to Round 4;
- If the Wheel Spin comes to rest on a "RAPTOR ATTACK" segment in Spin #1 and the Wheel Spin comes to rest on a dollar amount segment in Spin #2, the Contestant wins the Spin #2 amount and advances to Round 4;
- If the Wheel Spin comes to rest on a "RAPTOR ATTACK" segment in Spin #1 and the Wheel Spin comes to rest on a "JURASSIC PARK" segment in Spin #2, the Contestant wins \$5,000 for the "JURASSIC PARK" segment in Spin #2 and advances to Round 4;
- If the Wheel Spin comes to rest on a "RAPTOR ATTACK" segment in Spin #1 and the Wheel Spin comes to rest on a "RAPTOR ATTACK" segment again in Spin #2, the Contestant wins \$10,000 and advances to Round 4;
- If the Wheel Spin comes to rest on a "RAPTOR ATTACK" segment in Spin #1 and has two (2) ineligible Spins in Spin #2, the Contestant wins \$500 in Spin #2, and advances to Round 4; or
- If the Contestant received \$500 for not meeting eligible Spin requirements in Spin #1 and Spin #2, the Contestant wins the \$500 in Spin #1, plus \$500 in Spin #2, and the advances to Round 4.

Round 3 Cash Prizes range from five hundred dollars (\$500) up to fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000).

Round 4

This game will feature a button (the "**Button**") and a digital prize which continuously moves around a digital prize board displaying eighteen (18) squares (the "**Prize Board**"). Each Contestant will press the Button up to three (3) times (each, a "**Stage**"), to win a Cash Prize amounting to up to one million dollars (\$1,000,000). The Prize Board squares will each display one of the following prize symbols and corresponding values:

- "DINO TRACKS" prize symbol = one thousand dollars (\$1,000);
- "JUNGLE" prize symbol = one thousand five hundred dollars (\$1,500);
- "SHAVING CREAM" prize symbol = two thousand dollars (\$2,000);
- "PARK VEHICLE" prize symbol = two thousand five hundred dollars (\$2,500);
- "DNA STRAND" prize symbol = three thousand dollars (\$3,000);
- "JURASSIC PARK" Logo prize symbol = five thousand dollars (\$5,000); and
- "VELOCIRAPTOR" prize symbol = will reduce Cash Prizes won in Stage #2 or Stage #3 by one-half (½).

The Contestant will be given the chance to press the Button up to three (3) times and will win the total combined Cash Prize value (the "**Round 4 Bankroll**") from Stage #1 - 3.

Stage #1: The "VELOCIRAPTOR" prize symbol will not appear on the first Prize Board. The Contestant will press the Button, and the lighted marker will randomly land on one (1) of the prize symbols on the Prize Board. The Contestant will win the corresponding Cash Prize amount

revealed on the selected prize symbol. After Stage #1, the Contestant has the option to end CHALLENGE game play or proceed to Stage #2 with their Round 4 Bankroll.

Stage #2: If Contestant proceeds to Stage #2, three (3) "VELOCIRAPTOR" prize symbols will be added to the Prize Board in place of three (3) prize symbols. The Contestant will press the Button, and the lighted marker will randomly land on one (1) of the prize symbols on the Prize Board. If the lighted marker lands on the "VELOCIRAPTOR" prize symbol in Stage #2, this symbol reduces Stage #1 winnings by one-half (½). If the lighted marker lands on one of the other prize symbols for Stage #2, the corresponding Cash Prize amount is added to the Stage #1 amount and the Contestant has the option to end the CHALLENGE or proceed to Stage #3 with their Round 4 Bankroll.

Stage #3: If Contestant proceeds to Stage #3, four (4) additional "VELOCIRAPTOR" prize symbols will be added to the Prize Board in place of four (4) prize symbols. The Contestant will press the Button, and the lighted marker will randomly land on one (1) of the prize symbols on the Prize Board. If the lighted marker lands on the "VELOCIRAPTOR" prize symbol in Stage #3, this symbol reduces the Contestant's total combined money won in Stage #1 and #2 by one-half (½). If the lighted marker lands on one of the other prize symbols for Stage #3, the corresponding prize amount is added to the Contestant's total combined money won in Stage #1 and #2 and game play ends.

In the event a Contestant wins one thousand dollars (\$1,000) in Stage #1 and the lighted marker lands on "VELOCIRAPTOR" in the subsequent two (2) Stages, the Contestant will be awarded the Round 4 minimum Cash Prize of three hundred twenty-five dollars (\$325).

Round 4 Bonus Cash Prize

If the Contestant lands on the same prize symbol in all three (3) Stages #1 - #3, the Contestant will receive a Bonus Cash Prize as follows:

- If three (3) squares display a "DINO TRACKS" prize symbol with dollar amount of "\$1,000", the Contestant wins three thousand dollars (\$3,000) plus a Bonus Prize of seventeen thousand dollars (\$17,000) for a total prize of twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000);
- If three (3) squares display a "JUNGLE" prize symbol with dollar amount of "\$1,500", the Contestant wins four thousand-five hundred dollars (\$4,500) plus a Bonus Prize of thirty-five thousand five hundred dollars (\$35,500) for a total prize of forty thousand dollars (\$40,000);
- If three (3) squares display a "SHAVING CREAM" prize symbol with dollar amount of "\$2,000", the Contestant wins six thousand dollars (\$6,000) plus a Bonus Prize of fifty-four thousand dollars (\$54,000) for a total prize of sixty thousand dollars (\$60,000);
- If three (3) squares display a "PARK VEHICLES" prize symbol with dollar amount of "\$2,500", the Contestant wins seven thousand-five hundred dollars (\$7,500) plus a Bonus

Prize of seventy-two thousand five hundred dollars (\$72,500) for a total prize of eighty thousand dollars (\$80,000);

- If three (3) squares display a "DNA STRAND" prize symbol with dollar amount of "\$3,000", the Contestant wins nine thousand dollars (\$9,000) plus a Bonus Prize of ninety-one thousand dollars (\$91,000) for a total prize of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000); or
- Three (3) squares display a "JURASSIC PARK" prize symbol with dollar amount of "\$5,000", the Contestant wins fifteen thousand dollars (\$15,000) plus a Bonus Prize of nine hundred eighty-five thousand dollars (\$985,000) for a total prize of one million dollars (\$1,000,000).

Round 4 Cash Prizes and Bonus Cash Prizes (collectively the "Cash Prizes") range from three hundred twenty-five dollars (\$325) up to one million dollars (\$1,000,000).

SG reserves the right to modify specific game play provided such change does not result in a lower expected payout for the Contestant for the modified portion.

Additional Conditions:

- Prizewinner and guest shall be required to comply with the Department of Homeland Security's REAL ID Act and all other programs to attend and participate in the CHALLENGE. For more information, please see: https://www.dhs.gov/real-id.
- Prizewinners are subject to background investigation.
- If applicable, Prizewinner and guest shall be required to follow all health and safety protocols, including always wearing a facemask and following social distancing guidelines, as instructed by the event's staff and volunteers and all federal, state, and local guidelines relating to COVID-19 or any pandemic.
- Prizewinner's guest may sit with the Prizewinner but will not be eligible to be a
 participant in the CHALLENGE unless they have been designated as a Prizewinner's
 proxy.
- Prizewinner will be mailed the official CHALLENGE Details concerning the CHALLENGE prior to their trip departure.
- Age and other eligibility requirements to win the Trip Prize shall be determined by the LOTTERY; however, the minimum age requirement to play the CHALLENGE is eighteen (18) years per Hawaii State Law. The Prizewinner or their proxy must be eighteen (18) years of age to be eligible to participate in the CHALLENGE.
- All CHALLENGE Rounds will be audited by an independent auditor ("Event Auditor").

All Cash Prizes in the CHALLENGE (the "CHALLENGE Prizes") are underwritten by either SG, third parties, or both. All CHALLENGE Prizes shall be paid to the Prizewinner, less tax withholdings.

- The LOTTERY will issue an IRS Tax Form W-2G for the prize amounts won during the CHALLENGE.
- The Trip Prize is not for resale and is not transferable.

Participating lotteries shall have no liability for any CHALLENGE Cash Prizes.
- Upon the Prizewinner being validated by the LOTTERY, title to the Trip Prize shall immediately pass to the Prizewinner. The Trip Prize is not transferable or assignable by the Prizewinner, but may be assigned by the LOTTERY, as provided in Section 13(xvii), below;
- If a Trip Prize is refused by the Prizewinner or is not claimed within the timeframe determined by the LOTTERY, the LOTTERY will assign the Trip Prize to an alternate Prizewinner, and SG shall fulfill that Trip Prize under the same terms and conditions as specified herein, provided that the Trip Prize is still available and time requirements have not elapsed;
- All Cash Prizes won by the Contestants will be subject to the LOTTERY's debt setoff
 procedures. The Prizewinner may not choose to receive the cash equivalent of the trip
 portion of the Trip Prize.

 - The NCEL and its vendor(s) will not be responsible for data entry errors by entrants nor for connectivity issues involving the player's access to the NCEL's website or the Mobile App.
