

Request for Quote – Sports Betting Strategist Q&A

1. **RFQ section 1. Intent of the Request for Quote:** Would mobile sports betting include all forms of internet gaming access through browsers (for example: PC's / computers / tablets) and not just through mobile device applications?

In connection with this project, the Sports Betting Strategist will look to recent bills considered in the North Carolina General Assembly, as well as laws and regulations in states that have approved mobile sports wagering in order to (i) advise the North Carolina State Lottery Commission's staff about mobile sports betting and (ii) deliver the requested Scope of Services. The selected Sports Betting Strategist will be able to provide insights to the Lottery regarding both the hardware and software that may support internet gaming access from both "wired" and "wireless" devices.

Please refer to recent North Carolina Senate Bill 688 (A Bill to be Entitled An Act to Authorize and Regulate Sports Wagering in North Carolina) and Senate Bill 38 (Sports Wagering Amendments, A Bill to be Entitled An Act to Authorize and Regulate Sports Wagering in North Carolina). These materials are available to the public on the General Assembly's website (www.ncleg.gov) and will help inform the Lottery's planning process. By way of illustration (and not limitation), please review proposed definitions and related provisions concerning "interactive accounts," and a "sports wagering platform," as well as the proposed statutes concerning wagers at places of public accommodation.

2. **RFQ section 4.14 Disclosure of Litigation and Legal Matters:** Can this be addressed in a separate page within the Technical Proposal or is it required to be submitted as a separate document completely?

A contractor that responds to this RFQ is directed to include in its Proposal a "separate page" to serve as a "disclosure of any pending or overtly threatened civil or civil or criminal litigation or indictment." If needed, please utilize more than one page to provide the full disclosure within the Technical Proposal.
