

“Keno Vending Machine” Promotion **Terms**

Purpose

The North Carolina Education Lottery (“NCEL”) is conducting a promotion where purchasers of a \$5 7-Spot Keno ticket will receive a Keno ticket at a discounted price.

Promotion Period

This promotion will run from 5:00 am Wednesday, November 1, 2023 thru 2:00 am Friday December 1, 2023. These dates are subject to change at the sole discretion of the NCEL (the “Promotion Period”).

Promotion Execution

HOW TO QUALIFY:

To qualify a player must purchase a \$5 Keno 7-Spot ticket on any Game Touch Draw terminal device by selecting the specially marked Keno Discount offer button on the home screen. When the button is pressed a Keno 7-Spot Quick Pick ticket a \$5 Keno ticket will print for the upcoming Keno drawing and the player will be charged \$4. This is a \$1 discount off the purchase price.

This promotion is available only at locations that have a Game Touch Self Service terminal. It is not available on any other lottery selling device.
